Meeting Minutes

May 8, 2007

David announced that the opening of the new hospital center located between Stone Ridge and South Riding is scheduled for September 2007. That facility will host an urgent care, outpatient radiology, physical therapy, and many physician offices. David said that an application has been submitted for another site to be developed in the Avonlea Business Park.

Bill Dean thanked our lunch sponsor, Jim Brabham, OpenBand, and announced that Senator Herring was in attendance. Bill introduced the next speaker, George Phillips, Senior Transportation Planner, Loudoun County Office of Transportation Services.

George reminded the members of the DSBA that they were invited and encouraged to attend all of Loudoun County's Public Outlook Meetings.
